Livelihood Initiatives

Manami, NABARD – Dalmia watershed development project, Hulakund

- To enhance livelihood opportunities, loans have been provided to women engaged in livelihood activities.
- A loan amount of **Rs.1.80 lakhs** has been distributed among 18 members in Hulakund village under the Livelihood Support for Women and Landless scheme.
- With the support through loan distribution, 6 members are engaged in goat rearing, 6 members in animal husbandry, 5 members in tailoring, and 1 member operates a petty shop.
- Each woman is expected to earn an annual additional income of **Rs.0.35 Lakh.**



I Drip Irrigation

- Supported **7 members** in implementing drip irrigation, covering 23 acres of land.
- This initiative facilitated the cultivation of crops such as onion, sugarcane, and cotton.
- It also helped farmers by providing sufficient water to their crops.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an additional annual income of **Rs.10,000.**



Distribution of vegetable seeds:

- Vegetable seeds were distributed to farmers for the purpose of backyard kitchen garden.
- **75 farmers** were benefitted from this initiative.
- Each farmer has the potential to earn an additional annual income of **Rs.12,000/-**





Seed treatment for Jowar and Bengal gram produce

• Supported with seed treatment chemicals for seed treatment that would protect the crop from seedborne diseases.

It increases the yield up to 7 to 10 % per hectare.

150 beneficiaries were benefitted.

Chargeable power sprayer pump distributed to 400 farmers

- **31 SHG members** received a loan of 19.10 lakhs through bank linkage.
- This loan enhances livelihood opportunities for the beneficiaries.
