Livelihood Initiatives

Micro Enterprise Unit:

- 2 beneficiaries from Kallakudi were supported to start the new micro enterprise activities.
- Provided utensils for food stall business and Iron box to a beneficiary for Ironing shop.
- This will help the beneficiary to earn an annual income of more than **1 lakh rupees**.



E Auto Support

- A female beneficiary from Muthvathur was supported with an Electric Auto worth **Rs. 4.59 lakh** under the Pink Auto scheme.
- This initiative will help the beneficiary to earn an annual income of **Rs. 1.5 lakh**.
- In coordination with Dalmia Rotary club the support given to the beneficiary.



Milch Animal Support Through SHG internal Loan

- Through capacitating the SHG federations, the federations are performing well for eradicating the poverty in the rural villages.
- As part of this activity, 12 members from SHGs were supported with loan of **Rs.3.6 lakh** for purchasing milch animals.
- This support will enable women beneficiaries to earn an additional annual income of **Rs. 54,000 per family**.



Mat Making Training Program

- In partnership with the Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), a training session on mat-making was organized for 30 women members.
- This initiative enabled beneficiaries to develop mat-making skills and generate extra income independently.
- The training is complete, and we will soon be forming the beneficiaries into a group. This will help them purchase materials at a lower cost and increase their sales.

SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

WOW bus – Digital Literacy

- Wow Bus is a digital literacy platform providing villagers access to learn computer programs and raising awareness among farmers, women, and youth.
- Basics of computers training has been provided to **77 children** through the WOW bus. It helped the children to learn computer in their village itself.
- A CRM course has been started with **25 youths** from our villages in partnership with SIDBI.



Medical Camp:

- A general medical camp was organized in Dalmiapuram in coordination with the Rotary Club of Dalmiapuram and SRM Hospital, Trichy.
- 185 beneficiaries were treated, and **15 beneficiaries** were referred for further treatments.
