#### **Livelihood Initiatives / Water Initiatives**

#### I Training on Backyard Poultry

- Organized training on 'Management of Backyard Poultry' for the beneficiaries under 'Backyard Poultry' scheme.
- Training was done with the technical support from KVK, Yaganti.
- Purpose of this training is to provide technical inputs on various aspects of Backyard poultry i.e., 'Feed, and disease management, vaccination, breeding technics' etc.,
- 340 beneficiaries from 11 core area villages were benefitted.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of is Rs.
   35000/- per unit of 10 birds from this intervention.

#### Livelihood Loan distribution

Distributed Rs. 8 lakh Livelihood loans through VDC/ Watershed Livelihood Fund to the women in Nawabpeta village.

Beneficiaries have invested in livelihood activities like Milch animal management, Micro enterprises etc.

23 women beneficiaries were benefited from this scheme.

- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income
- from Rs. 36000/- to Rs. 60,000/-.





#### Sanitary Pad Making Unit.

Women of Shanthi Self Help Group were producing and selling Sanitary pads women customers like DCBL's plant colony, surrounding villages, town areas including Dalmiapuram and DIKSHa Belgaum.

- Purpose of the initiative is to support livelihood of SHG women and promoting menstrual hygiene in rural areas.
- 7 members from Shanthi SHG from Chinnakomerla village were benefitted from this project.

SHG group has generated revenue of Rs. 20,030/- by selling 781 packets.

#### Introduction


