## Livelihood Initiatives

### Goatery Management

- Administered Goat Pox vaccinations, dewormed, and provided liver and iron supplements to improve goat health significantly.
- Across 13 camps, a total of **1,949 goats** received these treatments, leading to marked improvements in their health and productivity.
- **307 households** were benefitted from this initiative.

The intervention is expected to provide an additional annual income of **Rs. 59,475** to each household.



### Construction of Water Harvesting Pond

- In Jirimgaon village, a pond was recently constructed with a capacity to hold **2700 kiloliters** of water.
- This project is intended to benefit 135 community members by addressing water scarcity issues and providing a reliable water source for agricultural and domestic needs.



## Bamboo Plantation

- In 25 villages, a bamboo plantation initiative was launched, benefitting **985 individuals**.
- **34,537 bamboo** saplings were planted in these villages.

This bamboo plantation helps to remove significant amount of harmful toxins from atmosphere.



## Micro Enterprise Support

- Moni Das opened a Tailoring Shop after receiving sewing machine from DBF. She expects to earn an annual income of **Rs. 1,10,400**.
- Samar Paul opened a Sweet Shop that caters to local villagers and walk-in customers. He anticipates earning an annual income of **Rs. 1,30,300**.

## Formation of Weavers Group

- Four group account opening forms were successfully submitted to the bank for the Weavers Group.
- This initiative aims to enhance financial management and access to banking services among weavers, thereby supporting their economic activities and promoting financial inclusion within the community.
