### **Livelihood Initiatives**

## Microenterprise Support - Sarathi Kitchen:

- Empowered a kitchen project by facilitating the construction of a safe and secure shed, equipping it with essential appliances like refrigerators and ovens
- · Sell over 60 meals (lunch and dinner) daily.
- The beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 2,16,000/-





## Microenterprise Support - Sima Fastfood Cart:

- Empowered street vendor by providing essential utensils for their carts, paving the way for increased income.
- This initiative has the potential to earn an annual income of Rs. 1,02,000/-.

## Microenterprise Support - Swapan Dairy:

- Invested in a high-yielding Jersey cow, producing 11-12 liters of milk daily, to boost dairy production.
- This initiative has the potential to generate an annual income of Rs. 72,000/-





## Groundnut harvesting by farmers:

- Enhanced agricultural production by enabling 80 farmers to cultivate groundnut as a second crop alongside chilies.
- These farmers are achieving impressive yields, averaging 2-2.5 quintals per farmer on their 10-katha plots.
- With market prices at Rs. 5,200 per quintal, this translates to a potential income of Rs. 10,400 Rs. 13,000 per crop cycle for each farmer.
