LIVELIHOOD & WATER INITIATIVES

DISTRIBUTION OF AZOLLA AND VERMI COMPOST BAGS

- Distributed azolla and vermi compost bags to **100 farmers** to enhance soil fertility and promote sustainable agricultural practices. This initiative supports organic farming while improving crop yields and environmental health.
- Each member is expected to earn an income from azolla is **Rs. 11,840** and from vermi compost is **Rs. 24,200**.





MANAMI WATERSHED DEVELOPMENT PROJECT, HULAKUND



Manami Watershed Development Project, Hulakund

- 624 trees were planted at the Primary Health Center in Yadwad, Hulakund, bus stands, government schools, and public places under the Agroforestry component.

Vermi compost tanks were constructed to promote sustainable farming and provide nutrient-rich compost, benefiting two farmers. Each is expected to **earn an additional ₹25,000 annually**.

LIVELIHOOD FUND SUPPORT

- A Livelihood Development Fund of **Rs. 1,60,000** of funds were allocated to support various initiatives **aimed at enhancing the members' livelihoods**.
- 16 women** members are part of this association.
- Constructed vermi compost tanks.

GOAT FARMING

- Supported **200 farmers** by providing one adult pregnant goat each to enhance livestock management and income generation.
- This initiative promotes sustainable farming practices, with each farmer expected to **earn an additional annual income of ₹15,350**, thereby improving the livelihoods of rural households.

MGNREGA JOB CARDS

- Facilitated MNREGA job cards for **75 members**, providing guaranteed employment opportunities under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA).
- Each member is expected to **earn an additional annual income of ₹31,600**, enhancing livelihood security and promoting economic development.

UNNATI GRAM ABHIVRIDHI SANGH SELF-HELP GROUP ASSOCIATION

- A Women's Self-Help Group (SHG) Association was established, comprising 10 SHGs from Kallakudi and Palaniyandinagar.
- 116 women members** were associated.
- Each woman is expected to earn an **annual income of Rs. 40,000**.

DRIP IRRIGATION SUPPORT

- Drip irrigation support was provided to **17 farmers** to promote efficient water use and improve crop yields. **This initiative can help farmers save up to 70% of water.**

PRIMARY HEALTH CENTER INAUGURATION



Primary health center inauguration

- The Primary Health Center was **inaugurated**, by **Sri Prabhat Kumar Singh, Unit Head of DCBL, Belgaum, and Sri Balachandra Jarakiholi, MLA of the Arbhavi Constituency.**
- This facility aims to enhance healthcare access and meet the medical needs of the local community.
- **28,333 population from 14 villages** will be benefitted.

HEALTH CHECKUP CAMP

- Organized a health checkup camp along with a medicine distribution program to provide essential medical services to the community of Tondikatti village.
- This initiative aims **to improve health awareness and ensure access to necessary treatments for residents.**
- **330 population** were treated and prescribed medicines for their illness.
