LIVELIHOOD INITIATIVES



Dairy development through AI

- 866 artificial inseminations (AI) were performed, with 129 using sex-sorted semen.
- Previous AI camps resulted in the birth of 236 calves, including 130 female calves. Among these newborn calves, 109 were buffaloes.
- The AI camps organized by the DBF team play a crucial role in elevating the income levels of households.

Livelihood Trainings

- Training sessions were conducted for 30 lead farmers in Azolla cultivation in collaboration with Krishi Vigyan Kendra.
- Dr. Gupta, an Agriculture Scientist from KVK, led the training sessions, which were informative, relevant, and useful for the participating farmers.
- The team is actively reaching out to 250 new farmers in a phased manner to facilitate the development of Azolla units.
- Additionally, training was conducted for 48 beneficiaries in Zari Zardozi work, connecting them through a buy-back arrangement.



Establishment of Azolla and Vermicompost Units

- 30 households were provided with Azolla beds to enhance the quality and quantity of milk.
- Azolla units have the potential to increase income up to Rs. 18,000 for households having two cows.
- Vermicompost beds were distributed to 370 households. Efficient utilization of these beds could result in the community producing more than 350 tons of compost manure, effectively replacing a considerable quantity of chemical fertilizers.
- Each vermi unit has the potential to yield 1 ton of compost manure annually, valued at around Rs. 12,000. This also leads to an increase in cane yield over 2 years, creating additional income potential of up to Rs. 10,000.

Introduction

The Gram Parivartan Program was launched with the aim of providing livelihoods that are economically sustainable, ecologically responsible, and socially equitable. The objective is to foster sustainable economic progress within selected communities, where household chosen for participation is expected to achieve an additional annual income of Rs. 1,00,000. This can be achieved through individual or group interventions and can function independently or converged with government programs.

A SUCCESS STORY FROM LIVELIHOOD INITIATIVE



Shiv Kumar Singh, a resident of Bajheda village, supports his family of six daughters and one son as a marginal farmer with 1.5 acres of rain-fed land.

Three years ago, Shiv Kumar invested in a desi-breed cow for Rs. 5,000. With the support of the DBF team, he successfully inseminated the cow, resulting in the addition of a female calf to his household. Initially yielding around 5 liters of milk per day, the cow has now produced a second calf. Notably, the firstborn female calf has also undergone insemination and is expected to deliver a calf in the next two months.

As per the veterinary doctor, the desi cow was inseminated with jersey variety semen, suggesting that the recently inseminated calf is likely to produce 10 to 12 liters of milk per day after delivery. In two months, Shiv Kumar anticipates selling an additional 10 liters of milk alongside the quantity collected from the desi cow.

The combined milk production from both cows is projected to increase his annual income by Rs. 1 lakh.
