Livelihood Initiatives

Dairy Development through shorted and Conventional Al

- Milch animals are the most common and regular livelihood activity.
- Through BIAF, promoted milch animals through artificial insemination (AI) to increase dairy production.
- 59 conventional AI and 17 shorted AI procedures were conducted.
- 76 beneficiaries were benefited by the BIAF Artificial Insemination Program.

| IRESA Based Biogas Plants

- This project promotes sustainable living, enhances quality of life, and supports environmental conservation for the beneficiaries.
- 3 households received IRESA-based biogas plants under the Gram Parivartan project.
- They are now able to save Rs. 1000 to Rs.1200 per month and gain organic compost worth Rs.1,200 to Rs.1,500 per month.

- A garment shop by Kumkum Devi was inaugurated in the core village.
- She is expected to earn an annual income of Rs.**72,000/-** from this initiative.

A Success Story of the New Micro Enterprise Initiative



Cosmetic Shop

Brijesh Kumar, son of Ram Sevak and a resident of Dhakia Tiwari in Nigohi, Shahjahanpur, faced the responsibility of providing for his family at the age of 36. Initially employed in sugarcane fields, his income was insufficient to meet their needs. During a household survey conducted by DBF, he expressed his desire to open a cosmetic shop in his village, where none existed. Recognizing his aspiration, DBF supported him with 10,000 under the Gram Parivartan Project to initiate the micro-enterprise and also facilitated a bank loan of 1.5 lakh.

With this support, Brijesh initiated his cosmetic shop in the village. He earns a daily income ranging from 400 to 500, significantly improving his family's financial stability. His success serves as a model for young individuals aspiring to achieve economic self-sufficiency locally, without the need to migrate to urban areas for employment opportunities.

The Gram Parivartan Program was launched with the aim of providing livelihoods that are economically sustainable, ecologically responsible, and socially equitable. The objective is to foster sustainable economic progress within selected communities, where household chosen for participation is expected to achieve an additional annual income of Rs. 1,00,000. This can be achieved through individual or group interventions and can function independently or converged with government programs.
