### **Livelihood Initiatives**

#### | Distributed Crop Bar/ Metal Paar

- Distributed 1,000 Crop Baars/metal Paars across
- Increased crop yield by 4 tons per acre.
- Reduced the cost of fertilizer and weeding by 40-50%.
- Specific to sugar cane, this intervention led to savings of Rs. 29,150 per acre.





#### | Silage Bags distributed

- Distributed 700 silage bags which helps them to store feed or grains for their livestock.
- These airtight and water-resistant bags keep food fresh for livestock and prevent pests and mold
- Improving the value of silage feed is one of the main benefits of using these bags.
- Farmers can earn an additional annual income of Rs. 38,300 from milk sales.

#### Introduction

The Gram Parivartan Program was launched with the aim of providing livelihoods that are economically sustainable, ecologically responsible, and socially equitable. This can be achieved through individual or group interventions and can function independently or converged with government programs.
