# **Livelihood Initiatives**

### | Micro Enterprises

- 21 Micro Enterprises were supported under Gram Parivartan Project.
- This program aims to support the enterprises in reaching financial stability and sustainability.
- Each enterprise is expected to earn an average annual income of Rs. 1.32 lakh.



## Vishwakarma Shram Samman Yojana

- Vishwakarma Shram Samman Yojana, aims to uplift the skilled artisans and craftspeople, promoting their economic well-being and preserving traditional trades.
- Coordinated with the District Industries Center to enroll 70 beneficiaries, after training these beneficiaries got the Tool-kit for the respective trades.
- The trained Artisans have started their enterprise in Carpentry, Confectionery and Basket making.
- Each beneficiary is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 1.44 lakh.



### Sarayan Kush Mats.



- PepsiCo integrates Kush mats in logistics to empower women, prioritizing them in production and supply to boost financial empowerment in the supply chain.
- 250 women were supported through this initiative.
- Each woman is expected to earn an annual income of Rs. 1.40 lakh.

### Dairy Development Through AI:

- Through BAIF, promoted dairy production by using Artificial Insemination (AI).
- This initiative aims to improve milk yield and overall dairy production efficiency in the region, as milch animals serve as a primary livelihood.

78 conventional AI and 14 shorted AI procedures were conducted.

**86 individuals** benefitted, enhancing their dairy productivity and livelihood sustainability.

### IRESA Based Biogas Plants:

This project promotes sustainable living, enhances quality of life, and supports environmental conservation for the beneficiaries.

3 households received IRESA-based biogas plants under the Gram Parivartan project.

They are now able to save Rs. 1000 to Rs.1200 per month and gain organic compost worth Rs.1,200 to Rs.1,500 per month.

### Introduction

The Gram Parivartan Program was launched with the aim of providing livelihoods that are economically sustainable, ecologically responsible, and socially equitable. The objective is to foster sustainable economic progress within selected communities, where household chosen for participation is expected to achieve an additional annual income of Rs. 1,00,000. This can be achieved through individual or group interventions and can function independently or converged with government programs.

# **Empowerment through Entrepreneurship**



General Store

Kiran and her husband Arjun, residents of Village Bartal in Sitapur, were born differently abled and faced significant financial hardship without any land or direct income sources. Recognizing their need for sustainable livelihood, the Dalmia Bharat Foundation (DBF) supported them in establishing a general store named "Kiran General Store." To finance this venture, the couple secured a Self-Help Group (SHG) loan of Rs. 30,000, supplemented by an additional Rs. 10,000 from DBF.

This intervention has transformed their lives, enabling Kiran to earn a net income of Rs. 9,000 to Rs. 10,000 per month. The steady income has provided them with much-needed financial security and stability. Kiran and Arjun are now able to comfortably sustain their family, demonstrating the impact of targeted support and entrepreneurship in uplifting marginalized communities. Their story stands as a testament to resilience and the profound effect of well-directed assistance.

# SOCIAL INFRASTRUCTURE

### I Climate Resilient Cattle Shed:

- 3 Farmers constructed Climate Resilient Cattle Shed under the Gram Parivartan Social Infrastructure initiative.
- These sheds were designed with the wellbeing of the beneficiaries' cattle in mind, significantly enhancing milk productivity, improving animal breeding, and boosting general health.
- The Climate Resilient Cattle Shed will alleviate distress among animals, leading to an average increase of 1 liter of milk per day.
- This Climate resilient cattle shed will be replicated with 100 farmers through the MGNREGA Scheme with Zila panchayat, team has submitted 120 forms.



## Model Polling Booth-Showcasing Rural Lifestyle

- With District Administration support, promoted a Model Polling Booth to encourage voter turnout in General Elections, focusing on women, senior citizens, and youth.
- It achieved a voting percentage of 63%, the highest among all constituencies.



### Common Service Lab:

- 125 beneficiaries trained in Digital and Financial Literacy training.
- It Enhanced capacity for digital transactions and online services with in the host community.
- 105 members received benefits through E-citizen Services and it Improved access to government services and information.
